



TIMBER RIDGE SCHOOL RING OF HONOR CRITERIA AND SELECTION PROCESS

Former Student Athlete:

The candidate must have attended Timber Ridge School and successfully completed treatment goals and/or was discharged in good standing.

The candidate must have participated in one interscholastic sport.

The candidate must have been discharged from Timber Ridge School for at least 5 years.

The primary basis for selection into the Timber Ridge School – Ring of Honor will be:

1. demonstrating excellence while competing;
2. a positive role model demonstrating leadership qualities;
3. demonstrate a high level of sportsmanship; and
4. following discharge the candidate has demonstrated a high level of citizenship and values consistent with Timber Ridge School as demonstrated his current life experiences.

Former Coach at Timber Ridge School:

The candidate must have coached at least one sport for 3 years;

The candidate must demonstrate a high level of sportsmanship and leadership; and

The candidate must demonstrate the importance of character in each athlete.

Timber Ridge Staff, Athletic Director, or Citizen Benefactor:

The candidate must have directly benefited the Timber Ridge School athletic program of not less than 3 years;

The candidate would have contributed by:

1. personal involvement and support; or
2. financial support.

The candidate will be an individual whose efforts and talents provided leadership, administration, organization, direction, inspiration, positive contributions and motivation in the furtherance of sports, programs, teams, and athletes.

Timber Ridge School Posthumous Candidate:

Deceased candidate shall be given equal consideration, but the waiting period may be waived.
